## Full Manuscript

Times New Roman
$\square$ Font size 12
$\square$ Double spaced throughout, including notes
$\square$ Between 5,000 and 12,000 words (the word limit includes Abstract and Keywords)
$\square$ Author's affiliation, email address and institutional address
$\square$ Images, illustrations, tables and other supplementary materials, if any, should be clearly captioned, as stated in the IJAPS style guide
$\square$ The manuscript is written using English (U.K.) spelling (e.g. programme, recognise, analyse, etc.)
$\square$ Numbers below 10 are spelt in full
$\square$ References (in-text, etc) should be complete and accurate
The following, if applicable, must be clearly stated at the end of the manuscript:
An Acknowledgement should be placed at the end of the article text, before the References
$\square$ A statement, Compliance with Ethical Standards, must be made if the research involves human subjects/animals or informed consent; this statement should be placed after the Acknowledgement and before the References
$\square$ A Disclosure Statement on research involving conflict of interest must be declared after the Acknowledgement and before the References

## Abstract

One paragraph
Between 250 (min) - 300 (max) words
$\square$ Up to FIVE keywords in a separate line at the end of the abstract

## Format

$\square$ Margins - Normal (1" all around)
$\square$ IJAPS's style, using Chicago author-date

## Permissions (if applicable)

Permissions have been obtained for the use of images, illustrations, tables and other supplementary materials

## Ethics declaration (if applicable)

$\square$ Permission/consent/approval has been obtained in research that involves human subjects/animals or informed consent (e.g. private emails, interviews with writers, etc).
$\square$ See above about the statement, Compliance with Ethical Standards, which must be made at the end of the manuscript
